



# SONGS FOR GRAMMAR TARGETS

## PRESENT SIMPLE TENSE:



**Song: "What a Wonderful World" by Louis Armstrong**

Target: Present simple verbs to describe things in the world ("I see trees of green, red roses too...")

## PRESENT CONTINUOUS TENSE:



**Song: "Walking on Sunshine" by Katrina and the Waves**

Target: Continuous action verbs ("I'm walking on sunshine, whoa!")

## PAST SIMPLE TENSE:



**Song: "Yesterday" by The Beatles**

Target: Regular and irregular past tense verbs ("Yesterday, all my troubles seemed so far away...")

## FUTURE SIMPLE TENSE:



**Song: "Tomorrow" from the musical "Annie"**

Target: Will + base verb for future predictions ("Tomorrow, tomorrow, I love ya tomorrow...")

## PRESENT PERFECT TENSE:



**Song: "I've Got a Feeling" by The Black Eyed Peas**

Target: Present perfect tense ("I've got a feeling that tonight's gonna be a good night...")

## COMPARATIVES AND SUPERLATIVES:



**Song: "Bigger" by Justin Bieber**

Target: Comparative and superlative forms ("You got me feeling so much better, better, better...")

## MODAL VERBS:



**Song: "Lean On Me" by Bill Withers**

Target: Can, should, could ("Lean on me when you're not strong...")

## GERUNDS AND INFINITIVES:



**Song: "I Want to Hold Your Hand" by The Beatles**

Target: Infinitives ("I want to hold your hand...")

## CONDITIONAL SENTENCES:



**Song: "If I Were a Boy" by Beyoncé**

Target: Second conditional ("If I were a boy, even just for a day...")
