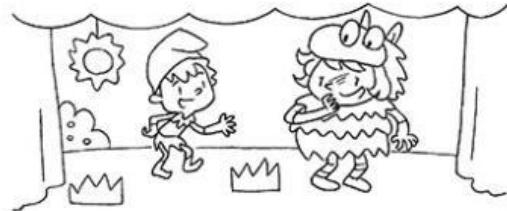

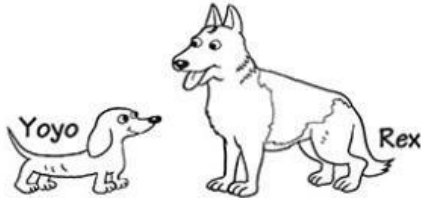

(2 things / people / animals)

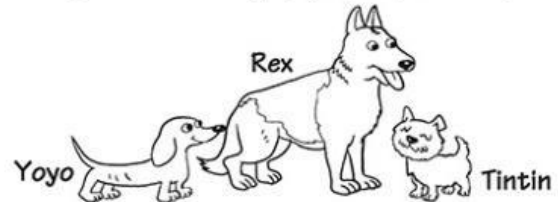


Yoyo is **smaller** than Rex.
 Rex is **heavier** than Yoyo.
 Yoyo is **thinner** than Rex.
 Rex is **larger** than Yoyo.

Use **-er** with short adjectives to form the comparatives.

superlatives

(3 or more things / people / animals)



Tintin is **the smallest** dog.
 Rex is **the heaviest** dog.
 Yoyo is **the thinnest** dog.
 Rex is **the largest** dog.

Use **-est** with short adjectives to form the superlatives.

friendly friendlier friendliest

change **y** → **i**, + **er / est**

nice nicer nicest

+ **r / st**

thin thinner thinnest

short vowel + consonant
 → double consonant + **er / est**

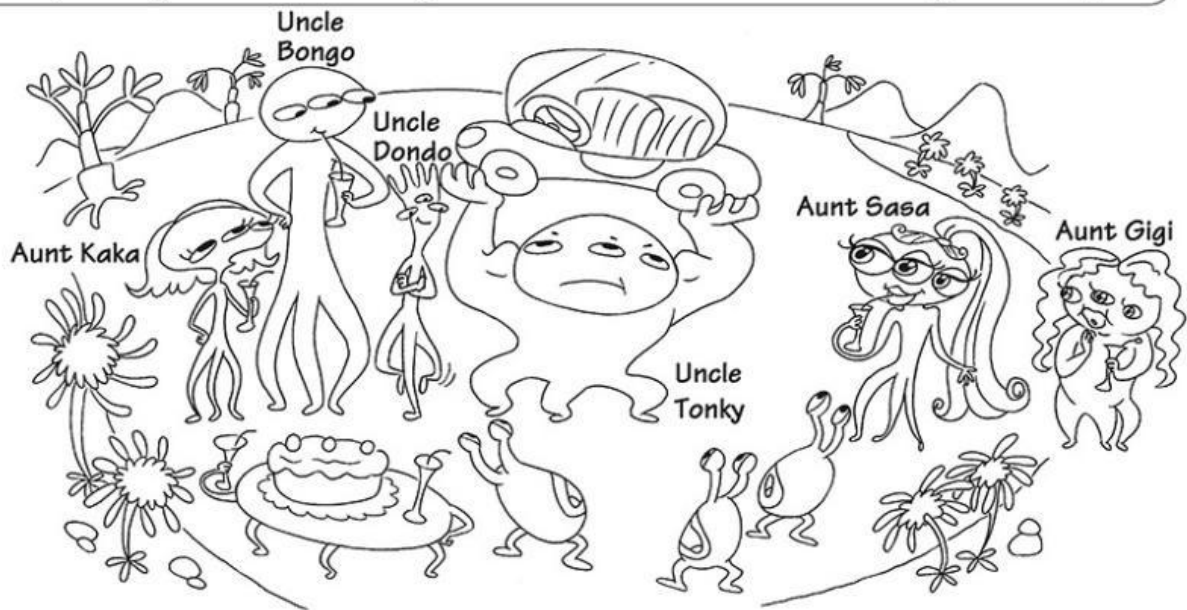
