# First Conditional

## Structure

**IF + Simple Present, Simple Future**

(S + will/won't + V(bare form))

## Usage

**To talk about possibilities in the present or in the future**

## Examples

- If it **rains**, I **will stay** at home.  
Si llueve, yo estare en casa.
- We **'ll go** to the park if it's **sunny**  
Nosotros iremos al parque si esta soleado.
- If I **don't wake** up late, I **won't miss** the bus.  
Si no me levanto tarde, yo no perdere el bus.
