(POSSIBILITY / PROBABILITY / CRITICISM / CERTAINTY / NECESSITY)

### REWRITE THE SENTENCES USING MODAL VERBS

CAN'T / MUST / SHOULD / SHOULDN'T / MAY / MIGHT / COULD / NEEDN'T

EXAMPLE: Maybe they **sent** the email to the wrong address.

They **might have sent** the email to the wrong address.

1. I'm sure you dropped your wallet at the bus stop.

2. Emma was wrong not to tell you the answer.

5. They arrived early, but it wasn't necessary.

6. It wasn't necessary for me to buy any food yesterday.

I \_\_\_\_\_ any food yesterday.

7. It was a bad idea for us to be rude to the policeman.

We \_\_\_\_\_ rude to the policeman.

8. It wasn't necessary for us to pay to get in.

We \_\_\_\_\_ to get in.

9. You were wrong to study so late.

You \_\_\_\_\_ so late.

10. It wasn't necessary to work hard.

I \_\_\_\_\_ hard.
