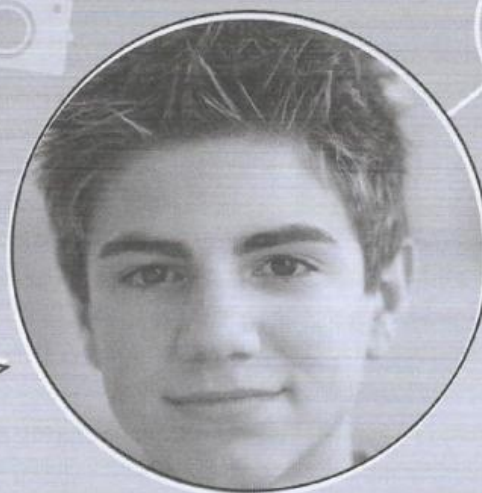


WORK EXPERIENCE
