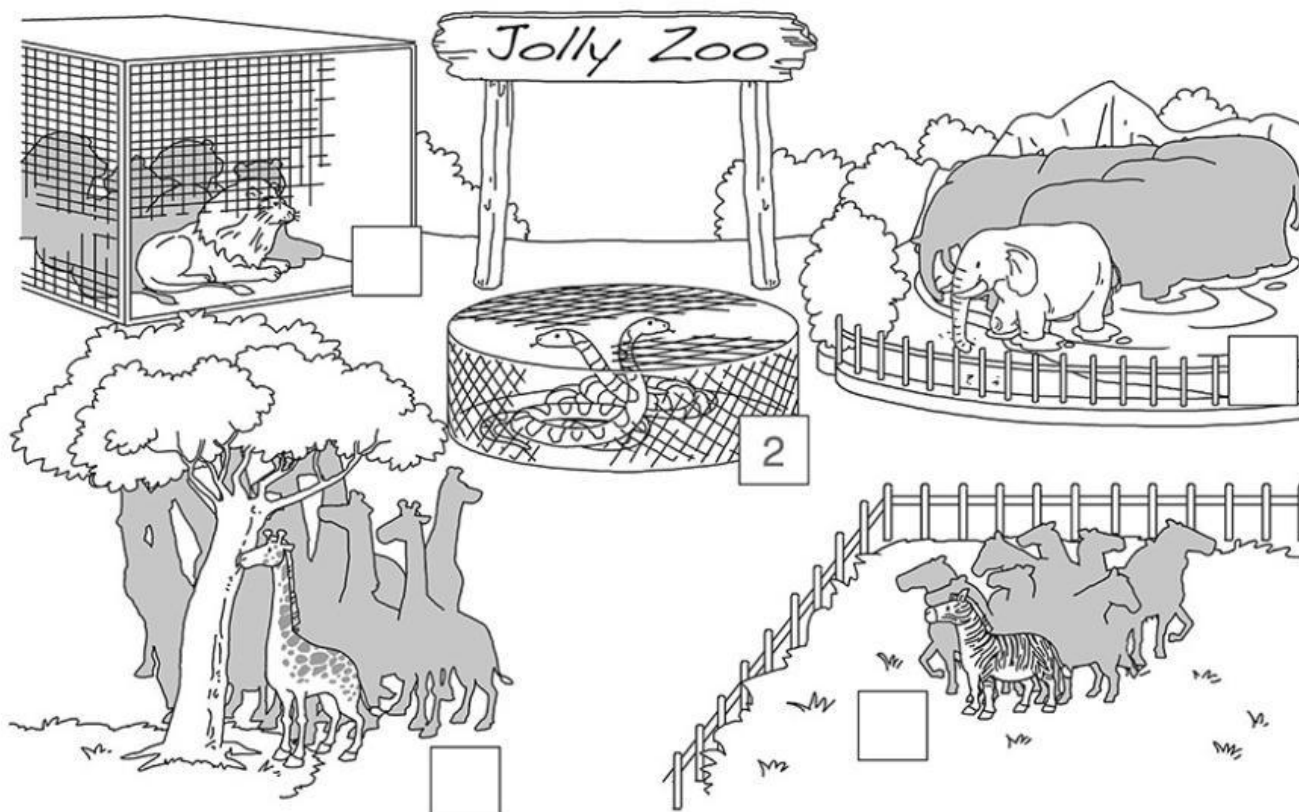

A Miss Wong is at the zoo with her pupils. She is reading a poem to them.

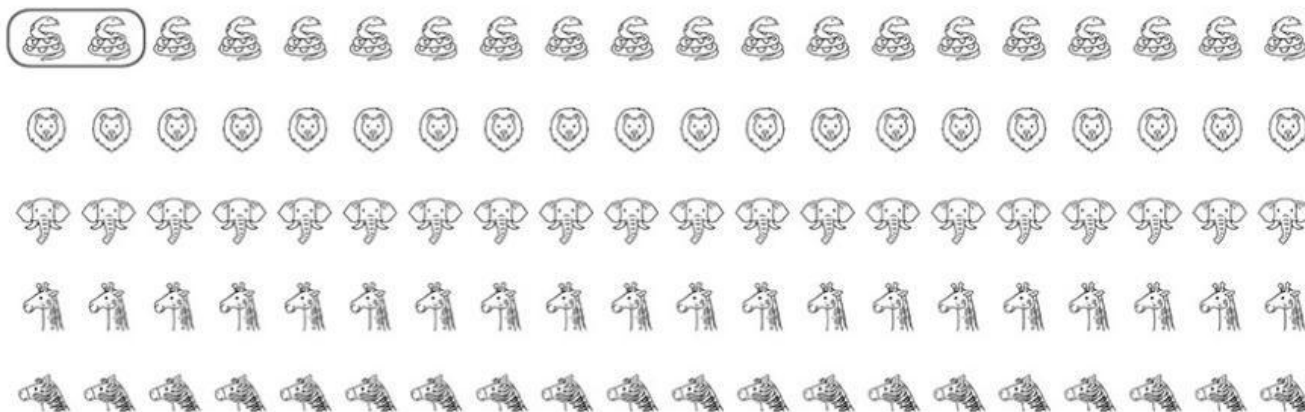

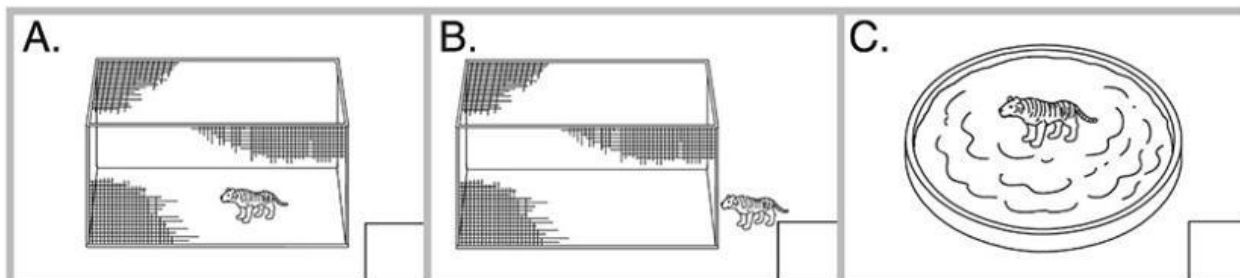

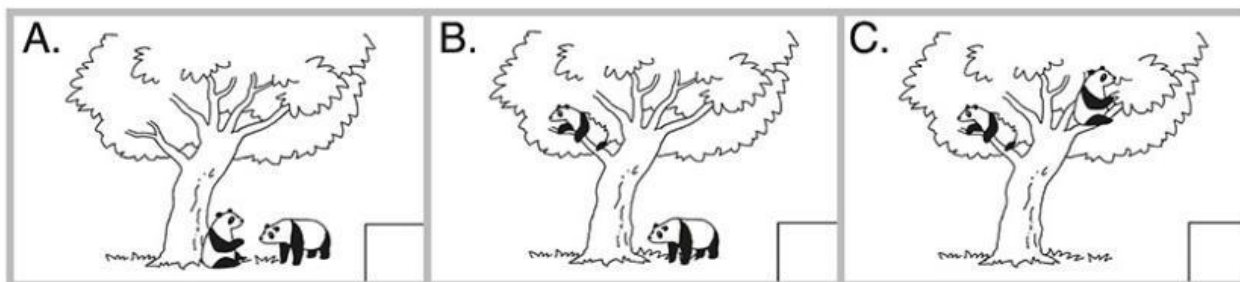
