

 Choose the correct equation for each word problem.

Jack saw 9 spiders in the web.

$$9 + 4 = 13$$

Kim saw 4 more spiders in the web.

$$9 - 4 = 5$$

How many spiders did they see in all?

You have 16 pencils.

$$16 + 9 = 25$$

9 roll away.

$$16 - 9 = 7$$

How many pencils do you have left?

You see 8 big cars and some small cars.

$$15 - 8 = 7$$

There are 15 cars in all.

$$8 + 15 = 23$$

How many small cars are there?

You have 6 books. You get some more.

$$14 - 6 = 8$$

Now you have 14 books.

$$14 + 6 = 20$$

How many more books did you get?

There are 17 dogs at the park.

$$17 + 8 = 25$$

Some dogs leave. Now there are 8 dogs.

$$17 - 8 = 9$$

How many dogs left?
