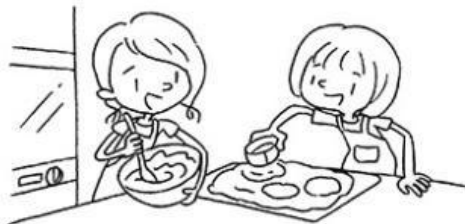


Simple past tense

We use the **simple past tense** to talk about things that happened in the past.

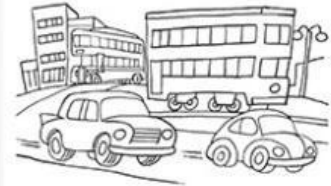
There was / were

~~There had~~There was an airport.There wasn't a theme park.~~There had~~There were buses.There weren't any MTR trains.**Practice**

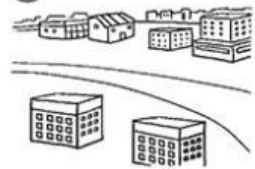

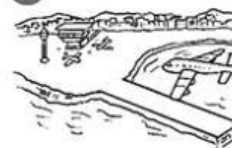
