Present continuous review

I	am <u>doing</u> a puzzle
You	are <u>doing</u> a puzzle
He / She / It	is <u>doing</u> a puzzle
We / You / They	are <u>doing</u> a puzzle

Am I doing a puzzle?
Are You doing a puzzle?
Is He / She / It doing a puzzle?
Are We / You / They doing a puzzle?

I am not doing a puzzle
You aren't doing a puzzle
He / She / It isn't doing a puzzle
We / You / They aren't doing a puzzle
