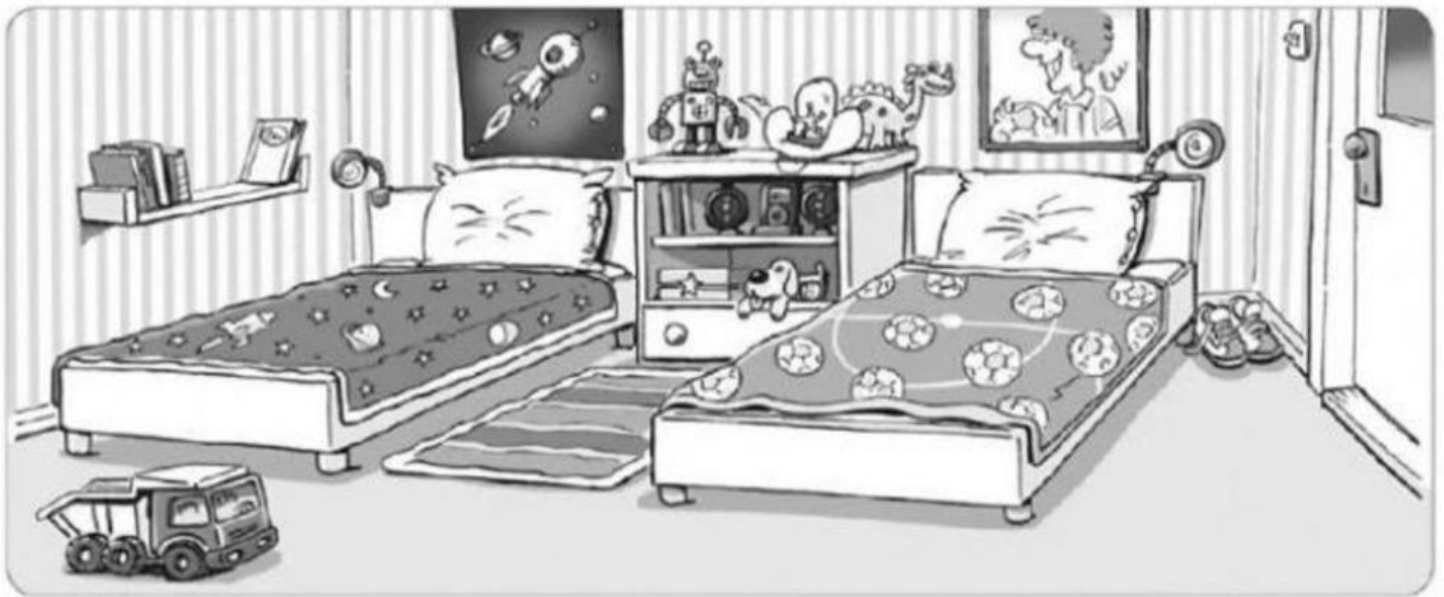

Task 4: Read and write True (T), False (F).

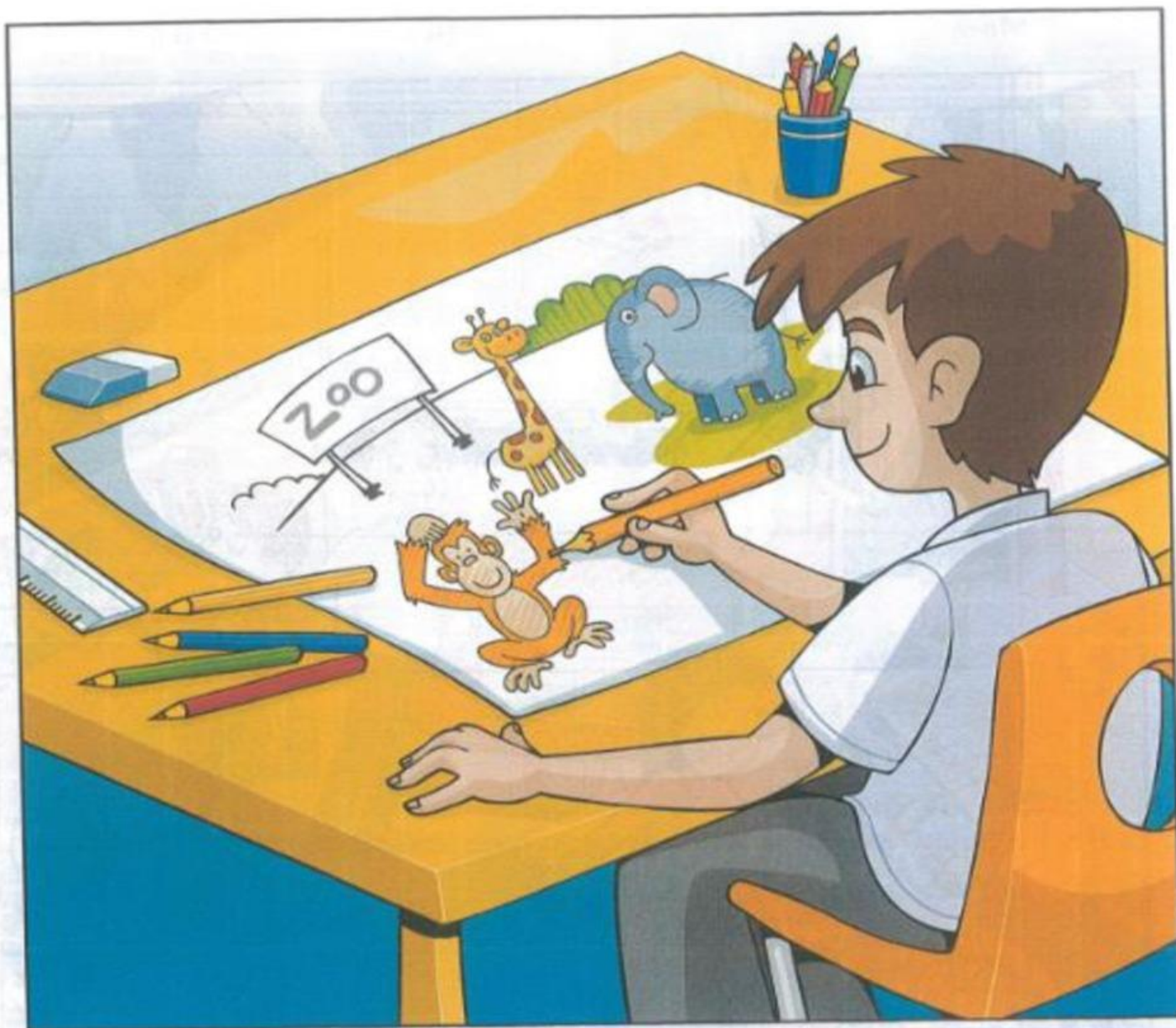
