We use **have to** + infinitive without **to** to say it is important or necessary for somebody to do something.

## Affirmative


I/You/We/They have to do homework.  
She/he has to do homework.

## Negative

I/You/We/They don't have to do a test.  
She/he doesn't have to do homework.

## Questions

Do we/you/they have to do your homework?  
Yes, we/I/they do. / No, we/I/they don't.  
Does he/she have to work on a project?  
Yes, he/she does. / No, he/she doesn't.
