

LONG I AND SHORT I

When a vowel sounds like its name, it's a long vowel. If a vowel does not sound like its name, it's a short vowel.

Examples:

pine

long i

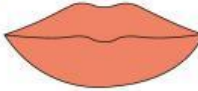
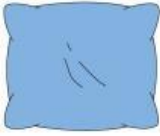
short i
