

Past Perfect Tense & Past Perfect Continuous & Past Simple

A) Choose between PAST SIMPLE and PAST PERFECT TENSE to give the correct form of the verb.

13. After they **finished/ had finished** (finish) their breakfast, they **left/ had left** for school.
14. Linda **played/ had played** tennis after she **did/ had done** her homework.
15. My father **watered/ had watered** the flowers after he **cleaned/ had cleaned** the car. After he **watered/ had water** the flowers, he **had/ had had** dinner.
