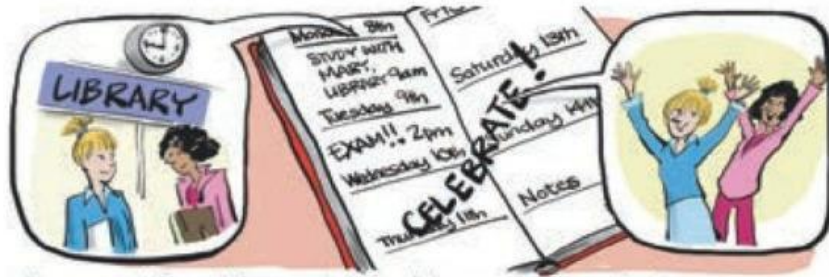


## 4A Present continuous and *be going to*
