Andy Love

Illustrator, designer, and author of children's books, Andy Love is a man of many talents. As well as illustrations, designs, and photos, he also creates apps, sculptures, and even clothes. Originally from Miami, in the U.S. Andy has traveled all over the world and has lived and worked in France, Ghana, and Java. Different cultures, especially those of West Africa and Indonesia, have inspired Andy's work. There have been more than five large exhibitions of his work, and he has an online gallery featuring his work. Like his heroes, Pablo Picasso and Henri Matisse, Andy is very interested in sculpture, particularly primitive figures and the art of West Africa. Also, when he was in Indonesia, he learned to paint using a technique called *batik*. This is the art of decorating fabric using wax and dye. When the colors are painted on the fabric, only the wax-free parts take the color.

Andy uses both sculpture and *batik* in many of his books, which usually take two years each to produce. In the first year, he works on the story and the ideas, and in the second year, he makes sculptures and paints textiles. Then he photographs his work and scans it into his computer. The entire process is like a performance.

His books have appeared in twenty languages and have won many awards. His first book, *My Punky Monkey*, was originally published in French. In his books, Andy has always aimed for his images to communicate so clearly that the reader doesn't need words to understand the message. Adults and children alike would agree he has achieved this goal with flying colors!
