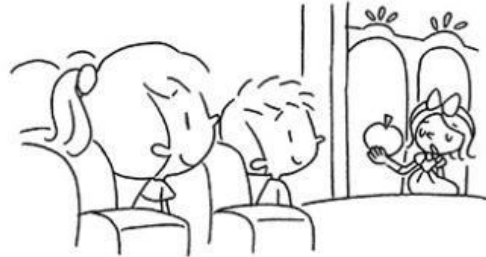


Instructions

Sit still in the hall.

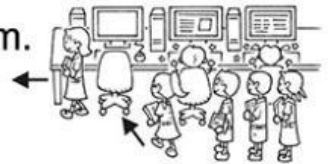


★ We can use a verb to start an instruction.
