and electrical messages.

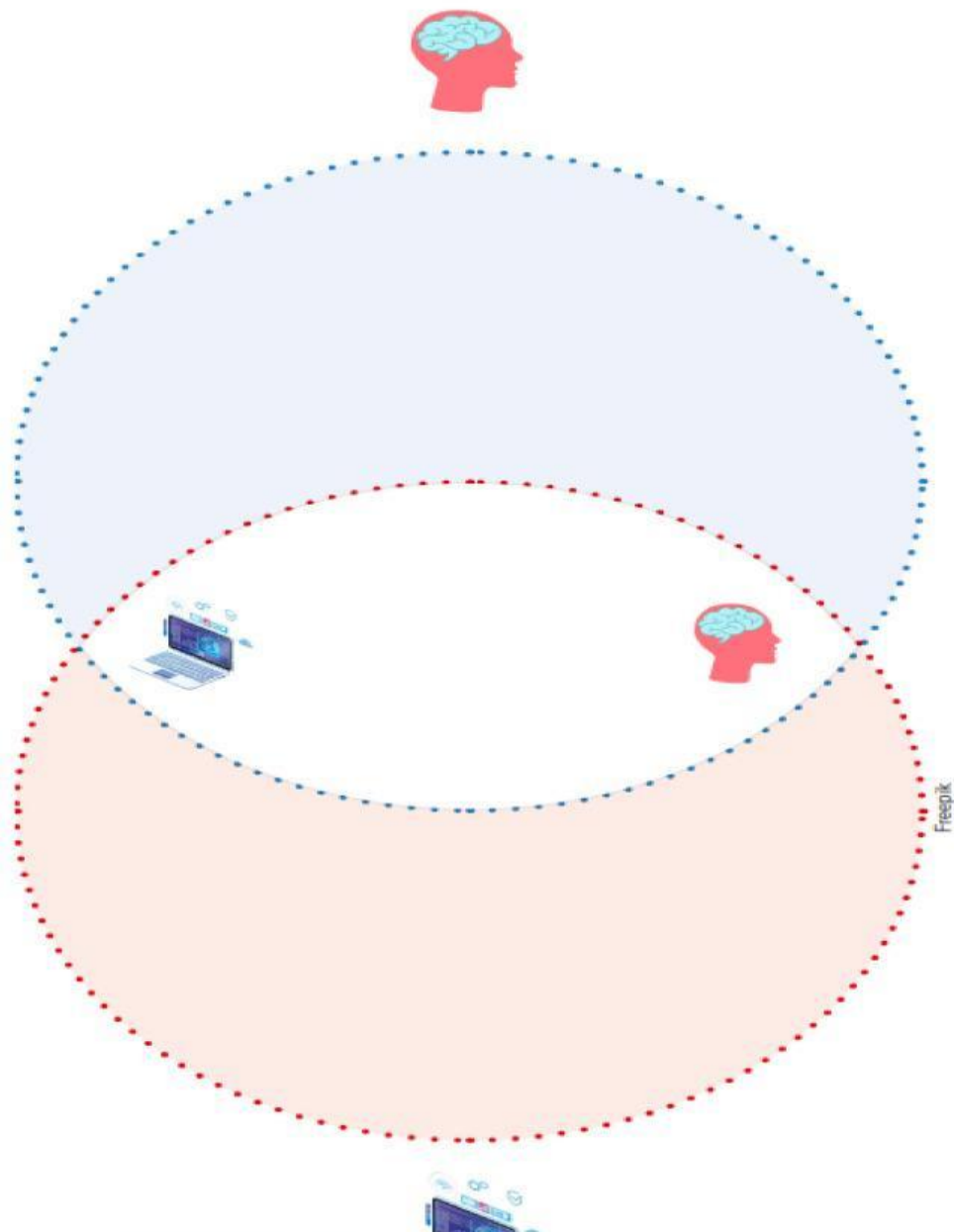
