

## MATERIAL

Salt and pepper to taste  
Grated cheese (optional)  
Butter

## STEPS:

1. **First**, crack the eggs into a bowl, add milk, salt and pepper. Beat until evenly mixed.
2. **Second**, heat a frying pan with butter over medium heat.
3. **Third**, pour the egg mixture into the heated frying pan.
4. **After that**, gently stir the egg mixture with a spatula. If you like, add grated cheese to the top of the mixture.
5. **Next**, once the eggs are half cooked, fold the omelette in half and let it cook completely.
6. **Finally**, remove the omelette from the pan and place it on a plate. Serve while warm.
