Ken : What is the matter? Are you tired?

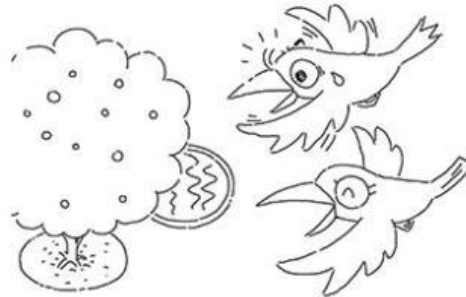
Kelly : Yes, I am very tired ... and thirsty ... and hungry.

Kelly : Good idea! I can see some berries too.

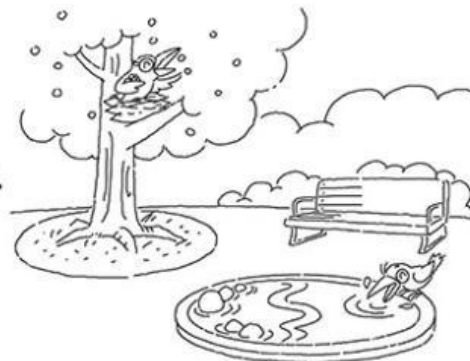


Narrator: The crows eat berries and drink water.

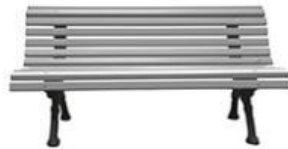
