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IS THERE ANY? ARE THERE ANY?



Instruction: read the rules about the use of *is there any?* and *are there any?*

Look at the rules.

- Use **is** to ask about uncountable nouns.

Is there **any** rice in the box?
Yes, there is./No, there isn't.

- Use **are** to ask about plural countable nouns.

Are there **any** apples in the fridge?
Yes, there are./No, there aren't.

Remember that the determiner **any** is used instead of a specific amount.
