Vocabulary (คำศัพท์)

- perfume (n.): a liquid that you put on skin to make yourself smell nice (น้ำหอม)
- touch (v.): to put your hand, finger, etc. on someone or something (จับ, แตะ)
- take off (v.): to remove something (ถอด)
- silly (adj.): having or exhibiting a lack of good judgment or common sense; foolish (โง่, ไร้สาระ)
- mean (adj.): unkind or unpleasant (ใจร้าย, เลว)



Idioms: (สำนวน)

- Don't be silly. หมายถึง อย่าโง่เง่า, ตลกขำ
- pick on someone หมายถึง แกล้งหรือหาเรื่อง ใช้กับเพื่อน ๆ เมื่อหมายความว่า แกล้งล้อกันบ้าง ๆ หรืออาจหมายถึงแกล้งจริงจังใน ความหมายว่า หาเรื่อง
