Niagara Falls

One of the most exciting nature spots you can see in North America is Niagara Falls. It is on the border of Canada & the U.S.

It connects Lake Erie and Lake Ontario. It is made of 3 waterfalls called The Horseshoe Falls, The Bridal Falls and Niagara Falls.

The falls were created about 10,000 ago by melting glaciers.

The first European to see them was French explorer Father Louis Hennepin in December 1678. About 2.7 million liters of water per second fall of the falls. The drop is about 50 meters long. It is an important source of hydroelectric power.

Visitors to the Falls can do many things besides the thrill of standing and looking at them. You can take a boat ride near the falls and see the rainbows coming from the water (wear your raincoat!) Near the falls you can find restaurants, amusement parks museums, etc. So, if you like fun and nature, Niagara Falls is for you!
