TIME EXPRESSIONS	In a few minutes, in 2020, later, on Monday, next week/ month/ Sunday, the day after tomorrow, this afternoon, tonight, tomorrow, tomorrow evening/morning			At 10:00 tomorrow This time tomorrow In two weeks from now In three hours		By then By this time tomorrow By the end of the week

STRUCTURES

TO BE (am, is, are) + GOING TO

USES

Action completed in a specific time in the future.

WILL BE + VERB-ING

WILL HAVE+ PARTICIPLE VERB

SUBJECT+ TO BE (am, is, are)
+ VERB-ING

WILL + VERB

Subject + verb (-s, -es)
Auxiliary verbs DO/ DOES

EXAMPLES

By this time tomorrow I will have done my homework.
By the end of the week I will have finished the game.

Action in progress at a specific time in the future

Future arrangement

-Plan
-Prediction (evidence)

-Promises
-Offer
-Predictions (no evidence)
-Spontaneous decisions

Referring to timetables (bus, train, airplanes...)

The class starts at 7 o'clock.
The parade doesn't start tomorrow.

I will be waiting in front of the cinema.
Terry will be singing on Friday.

She is going to have a party.
Are you going to travel on summer?

I will love you forever.
They will help you a lot.

I will be studying.
She won't be playing.
