Executive branch:

Responsible for executing the laws and administering the government. The head of the executive branch is the President of the Republic.



Legislative branch:
Responsible for making the laws. The legislative branch is formed by the National Assembly.



Judicial branch:

Responsible for interpreting the laws and resolving legal conflicts. The judicial branch is formed by the National Court of Justice.



Electoral branch:

Responsible for organizing and carrying out electoral processes. The electoral branch is formed by the National Electoral Council.



Transparency and social control branch:
Responsible for promoting transparency
and social control of the government. The
transparency and social control branch is
formed by the Council for Citizen
Participation and Social Control.
