

HOW TO RIDE A BIKE

A bicycle is a simple and wonderful machine that helps us travel. It has a comfy seat called a saddle where you sit. To direct, you use the handlebars. At night, a light on the bike helps us see.

To stop the bicycle, we use the brake. It's like pressing a button to slow down or stop. The bicycle also has gears that help it move smoothly. Gears are like different speeds – you can change them to make riding easier on hills or faster on flat roads.

So, when you ride a bicycle, you sit on the saddle, hold the handlebars to direct, use the brake to stop, and sometimes change the gears to pedal more comfortably. It's lots of fun!
