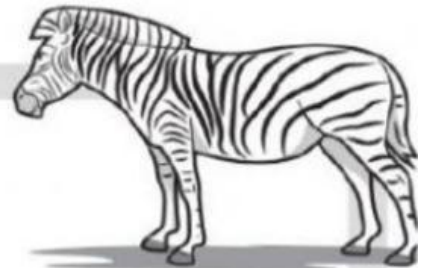

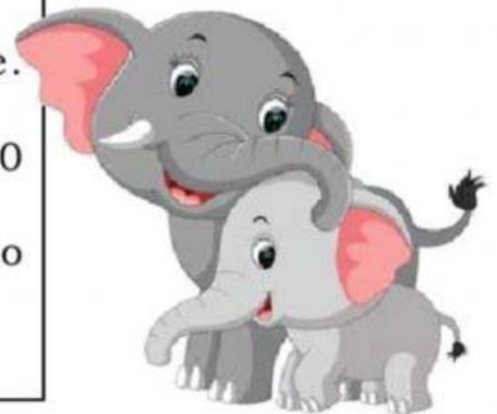
**Example** I have four legs and a tail. I'm not small. I'm friendly.
