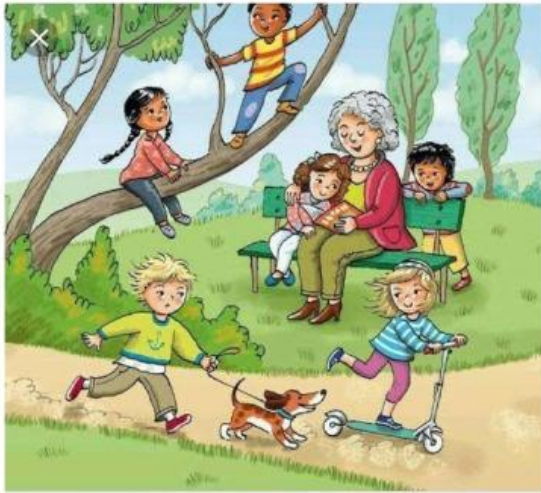


PRESENT SIMPLE OR PRESENT CONTINUOUS?
