at: shout at, at the moment, at the same time, stare at, arrive at (a place, not a city or country)

of: take care of, afraid of

in: in bed, in the morning, in the evening, in the afternoon, in my opinion

to: listen to, to my mind, pay attention to, give birth to

No preposition: go home, go abroad, go downtown, face problems, call sb, text sb, watch TV
