attraction (n) /ə'trækʃn/ → attractive (adj) → attract (v)	an interesting place which people want to visit	Đà Nẵng is one of the most popular tourist attractions .
participant (n) /pɑ:'tɪsɪpənt/ → participate (v)	a person who takes part in an event, competition, etc.	The participants are amazed at the beauty of the lanterns on the river.

Usage We use the **Future Simple** to give or ask for information about events in the future.

Form

Affirmative	Negative
I/We/You/They/He/She will take part in the race this month.	I/We/You/They/He/She will not/won't take part in the race this month.
Yes-No questions	Answers
Will we/you/they/he/she take part in the race this month?	Yes, we/I/they/he/she will . No, we/I/they/he/she won't .
Wh- questions	Answers
What will we/you/they/he/she take part in this month?	I/We/You/They/He/She will take part in the race this month.

We stress the syllable before *consonant* + *-ian* in nationalities ending in *-ian*.
