What is the difference between a college and university?

A **college** is typically a smaller institution that offers undergraduate programs, such as associate's and bachelor's degrees. Colleges may also offer vocational or technical programs, as well as certificate programs. Community colleges are a type of college that offer two-year associate's degree programs and are often more affordable than four-year colleges or universities.



An **university** is a larger institution that offers both undergraduate and graduate programs, including master's and doctoral degrees. Universities often have multiple colleges within them, such as a college of arts and sciences, a college of business, and a college of engineering. They may also have professional schools, such as a law school or medical school.
