

## Indefinite pronouns

- Zaimki nieokreślone tworzymy od słów: *some, any, no, every*.

Zaimków utworzonych od:

- **some** – użyj w zdaniach twierdzących;
- **any** – użyj w pytaniach i zdaniach przeczących;
- **no** – użyj, aby zdaniu twierdzącemu nadać znaczenie zdania przeczącego;
- **every** – możesz używać w dowolnym typie zdań.

	OSOBA	RZECZ	MIEJSCE
some	someone / somebody <b>ktoś</b>	something <b>coś</b>	somewhere <b>gdzieś</b>
any	anyone / anybody <b>ktokolwiek</b>	anything <b>cokolwiek</b>	anywhere <b>gdziekolwiek</b>
no	no one / nobody <b>nikt</b>	nothing <b>nic</b>	nowhere <b>nigdzie</b>
every	everyone / everybody <b>wszyscy</b>	everything <b>wszystko</b>	everywhere <b>wszędzie</b>

Uwaga!

*We didn't see anything = We didn't see saw nothing.* W zdaniu może być tylko jedno przeczenie !  
*Everybody / Everyone were was tired after the walk.* traktujemy zawsze jako liczbę pojedynczą !
