Learning about Adjectives

Adjectives EXCLUSIVELY perform a single function: describing a NOUN (which includes pronouns)

Please add missing punctuation marks and capital letters to complete the grammar of the sentences.

An ADJECTIVE comes mostly before a noun or follows a NOUN, with linking (to be) verbs such as get, become, or look. For instance, "It's getting dark."

An ADJECTIVE contributes additional details or info regarding a noun.

When describing a noun, a specific order should be followed—size before color.

Know how to recognize ADJECTIVES.
