1. Cách dùng *and*

Chúng ta dùng *and* để nối các ý tương tự nhau. Các ý này có thể là từ, cụm từ hay mệnh đề.

Ví dụ:

She is nice and kind.

(Cô ấy đẹp và tốt bụng.)

Phong likes reading books and playing chess.

(Phong thích đọc sách và chơi cờ.)

It's cheap and it's renewable.

(Nó thì rẻ và nó có thể tái tạo.)

2. Cách dùng *but*

Chúng ta dùng *but* để nối các ý tương phản hay trái ngược nhau. Các ý này có thể là từ, cụm từ hay mệnh đề.

Ví dụ:

He is handsome but unfriendly.

(Anh ấy đẹp trai nhưng không thân thiện.)

Lan is good at math but not good at English.

(Lan giỏi Toán nhưng không giỏi tiếng Anh.)

It's clean but it's expensive to build.

(Nó sạch nhưng chi phí xây dựng đắt.)
