- A flowing body of water that moves from higher areas to lower areas, carrying water and sediment.
- A large body of water surrounded by land, typically formed through natural processes.
- A vast body of saltwater that covers much of the Earth's surface, characterized by its immense size, depth, and diverse marine life.
- A natural feature where water flows rapidly over a steep cliff or rock ledge, creating a beautiful and dramatic cascade of water.
- A narrow, flowing body of freshwater that winds its way through the landscape, originating from springs, lakes, or melting snow.
