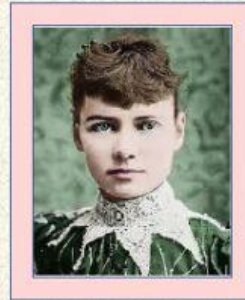


Women in Journalism : Nellie Bly

4/ Focus on : past simple , question form. Observe ces différentes propositions :

a) **Did** Nellie Bly ever **marry** ? Yes, she eventually **married** in 1895.

b) **Where did** she **go** during her journey ? She **went** all over the world.

Observe ce qui se passe dans ces deux phrases interrogatives :

WH-	auxiliaire	sujet	verbe	complément
	Did	Nelly	marry	?
When	did	she	start	her journey ?

A la forme interrogative, au prétérit simple (ou « past simple ») , on utilise l'auxiliaire **DO au** ; c'est lui qui permet de former la Le verbe, lui , n'est plus , il est à l'.....



Attention : Dans la réponse, si elle est affirmative, « Did » disparaît. Il faut alors penser à conjuguer le verbe au prétérit simple (ou « past simple ») !
