5. A: I hear you've bought a caravan. ¹⁰ **Are you using /**

Do you use/ Are you going to use it for your holidays?

B: No, I ¹¹ **am living / am going to live / live** in it.

A: What ¹² **are you doing / are you going to do /**

will you do with your house?

B: I ¹³ **am going to sell / am selling / will sell** it to

the man who sold me the caravan. He ¹⁴ **is going to get /**

is getting / will get married next month.

6. A: We ¹⁵ **are going to start / are starting / will start**

early tomorrow. We ¹⁶ **are going / are going to go /**

will go to Ben Nevis.

B: ¹⁷ **Are you going to climb / Are you climbing /**

Will you climb Ben Nevis?

A: Not me. Tom ¹⁸ **is going to climb / is climbing /**

will climb it. I ¹⁹ **will sit / am going to sit / am sitting**

at the bottom and do some sketching.

7. A: I'm afraid I'm not quite ready.

B: Never mind. I ²⁰ **am going to wait / will not wait /**

will wait.
