★ COMPARATIVES AND SUPERLATIVES! ★

Argentine people **are more** loving than English people. Argentines are **the most** loving people.



We compare one country with another.



We say one country is the most loving (for example) in the world!

For doing this we need to follow the structures and the rules!

Argentine people are **more** loving **than** English people.

we add the word **more** + adjective and the word **than** to compare the subject with an object.

French are **more** elegant **than** German.

*She is **more** beautiful than he.*

These flowers are **more colorful** than
the other ones.

we add the word **most** with the article **the** + adjective to compare the subject meaning is superior in the world.

French are **the most** elegant.

*She is **the most** beautiful girl at the school.*

These flowers are **the most**
colorful of the garden
