- Here, the **adjectives** “smelly,” “wet,” and “brown” provide additional characteristics about the noun “dog.”

Here are some of the rules for **Adjective**:

- Adjectives usually come before the noun they modify
- Don't add an -s to the ADJECTIVE. It stays the same
- no matter how many things you're describing. If the verbs 'be, seem, get, become' or 'appear' are used, the adjective follows them.
- The adjective also follows verbs that express the perception of the senses (sense verbs) such as 'feel, taste, look, sound, smell'.
- "Adjectives can be described more specifically by using words called adverbs. These adverbs go before the adjective to tell us more about it."
