HIJACKED JETS DESTROY THE TWIN TOWERS

NEW YORK, Sept. 12

In a horror sequence of destruction, terrorists hijacked two airlines and crashed them into the World Trade Center in a coordinated series of attacks on September 11 that brought down the twin towers.

All flights were grounded at Lindbergh Field as the nation's airline was shut down in the wake of what appeared to be coordinated terrorist attacks in New York and Washington. Security was heightened at government and military facilities around the country, and some downtown office buildings were evacuated.

For many people, the attacks were the biggest news story of their lifetime. Almost all who experienced it can remember where they were when they heard of the attacks.

Assault leaves Manhattan in chaos. Three of the flights were on route to L.A., one to San Francisco.
