Tuckerbean floats like a balloon and he feels better.

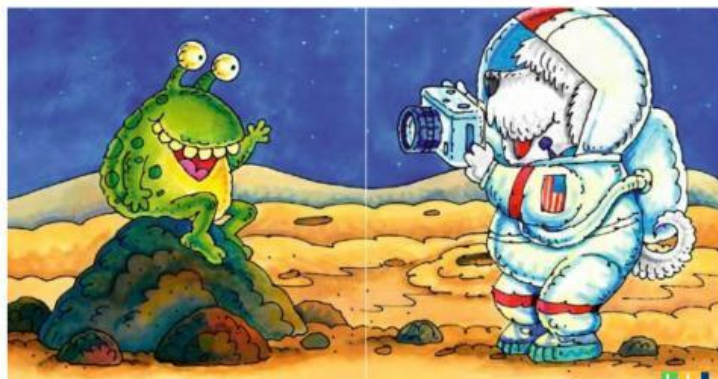
When the rocket lands, Tuckerbean and his crew jump out. They have a parade.
