REMEMBER

We use adverbs of frequency to talk about how often we do something. We put them before most verbs.

I / You / We / They	usually	do homework on Thursday.
He / She	sometimes	gets up early.

Do	I / you / we / they	ever	catch the bus?	Yes, I always catch the bus.
				No, I never catch the bus.
Does	he / she	ever	get up late?	Yes, he often gets up late.
				No, he never gets up late.
