1. In a garden, there are 856 red roses, and the rest are white roses. If there are 1,204 white roses in total, how many roses are there in the garden?
2. A pet store has 248 dogs, 375 cats, and 187 birds. How many pets are there in total?
3. There are 1,568 students in a school. If 645 of them are in the first grade and 789 are in the second grade, how many students are in the third grade?
4. A farmer harvested 864 apples from one orchard, 725 from another, and 1,103 from a third orchard. How many apples did the farmer harvest in total?
5. In a zoo, there are 456 monkeys, 298 lions, and 587 giraffes. How many animals are there in total?
6. A factory produced 3,785 toys in the morning shift, 2,654 toys in the afternoon shift, and 1,987 toys in the night shift. How many toys did the factory produce in total?

7. A bakery sold 356 croissants in the morning, 487 in the afternoon, and 698 in the evening. How many croissants did the bakery sell in total?

8. A company shipped 876 packages by air, 1,234 by sea, and 567 by road. How many packages did the company ship in total?

9. There are 2,568 books in the fiction section of a library, 3,489 in the non-fiction section, and 1,234 in the reference section. How many books are there in total?

10. A grocery store sold 857 apples, 1,205 bananas, and 689 oranges. How many fruits did the store sell in total?
