

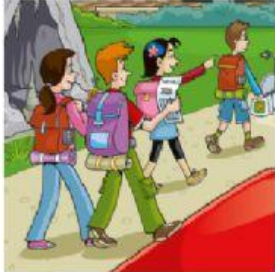
Activity 2 (5 questions)
