Structure of first movement of Symphony or Sonata. 3 sections: Exposition, Development, Recapitulation.	Main song from an Opera or Oratorio. Ternary form with ornaments on return of Section A.
A form in which there is little or no repetition of the music.	The first section of a movement in sonata form.	Variations over a ground bass.	Harpsichord and bass line accompaniment from the Baroque period.
