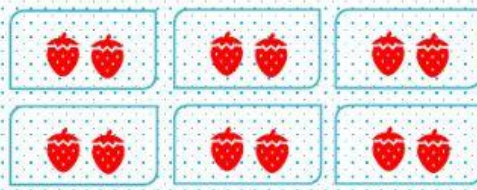

$$6 \times 2 = 12$$

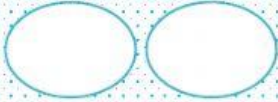
