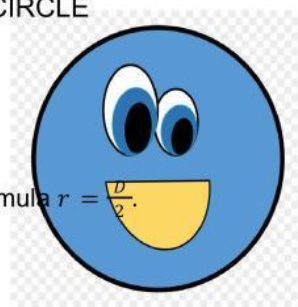

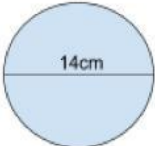

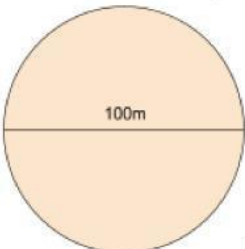
RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN RADIUS AND DIAMETER OF A CIRCLE WORKSHEET

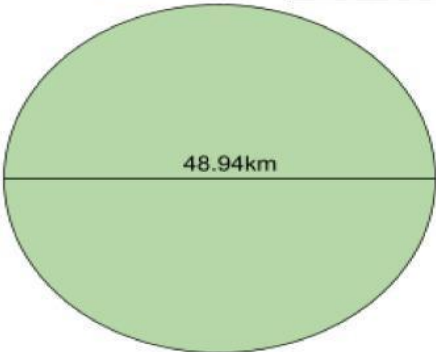


We can find the radius of a circle when we know its diameter using the formula $r = \frac{D}{2}$.

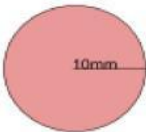
Use this knowledge to find the radius for the circles below.

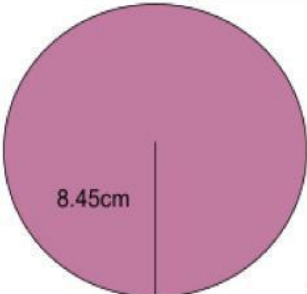
