‘Where are the sandwiches?’

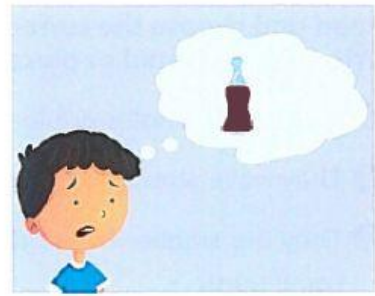

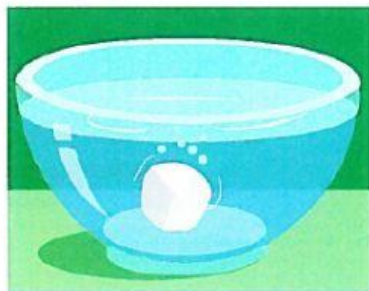

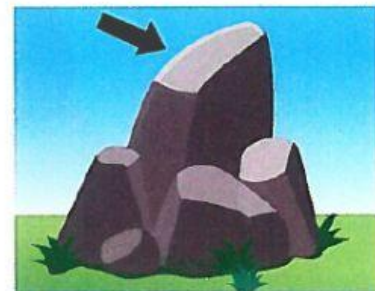
