Vietnamese people celebrate the Lunar New Year every year. Tet is generally celebrated on the same day as Chinese New Year (also called Spring Festival), except when the one-hour time difference between Viet Nam and China results in the new moon happening on different days. It takes place from the first day of the first month of the Vietnamese calendar (around late January or early February) until at least the third day. Many Vietnamese and Hoa prepare for Tet by cooking special holiday food and cleaning the house. These foods include *bánh tết*, *bánh chưng*, *bánh dày*, *canh kho qua*, *thịt kho hột vịt*, dried young bamboo soup, *giò*, and sticky rice. Many customs and traditions are practiced during Tet, such as visiting a person's house on the first day of the new year, wishing New Year's greetings, giving lucky money to children and elderly people, opening a shop, visiting relatives, friends and neighbors. *Tet Nguyen dan* is also an occasion for pilgrims and family reunions. They start forgetting about trouble of the past year and hoping for a better and happier coming year.
