A new United Nations report says that we should all eat insects. A. ____ It is called "Edible Insects: Future Prospects for Food and Feed Security". The U.N. says it is important that we eat insects to help the Earth. It gave three reasons why we should be adding insects to our diet. B. ____ 'Insects are healthy, nutritious alternatives to everyday food such as chicken, pork, beef and even fish.' The second reason is they are better for the environment than breeding cows, sheep, and other animals. Finally, 'insect farming' would help millions of poor families around the world eat and start a small business.
