

WINDY




RAINY

These words are simple ways to talk about the weather but... Are they enough? Weather is more complex and diverse. There are other weather events in nature.


Think about **TEMPERATURE** for example:



HOT



MILD



COLD

What's the temperature right now in your place? You can also use these expressions:



IT IS BOILING HOT



IT IS FREEZING COLD



IT IS WET

The opposite is:

IT IS DRY

★ WEATHER FORECAST!

Let's listen to the weather forecast and answer some questions about the information from the audio:

- What's the weather like in the north?
- What's the weather like in the east?
- What's the weather like in the west?
- What's the weather like in the south?

We use the expression:

IT'S RAINING CATS AND DOGS

when it is raining heavily.



That's not all! We have more specific words related to rain, wind and storms!



DRIZZLING RAIN:

When it rains a little and small drops fall.



HAIL:

When pieces of ice fall from the sky.



OVERCAST:

When there are big and dark clouds in the sky.



LIGHTNING:

When electricity is produced during a storm.



BLIZZARD:

When there is a storm with strong winds and snow.



FLOOD:

When it rains a lot and streets, cars and buildings are covered in water.

There are more words that are similar to our language!



TORNADO



VOLCANO



HURRICANE
